# Make \$1.00 using exactly 21 coins



You have a jar of change with \$6.15 in it. As you're counting it, you notice that you have exactly the same number of pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters. How many coins are in the jar?



If Bill Gates has \$30 billion and decides to share it with each of 300 million Americans, how much will you get?



Several students want to pitch in for a gift for their awesome math teacher. If five students chip in it will cost each one \$2 more than if seven chip in. How much is this wonderful gift?



You and I chip in to pay for a \$5 box of 35 cookies. If I put in \$3 and you put in \$2, how many cookies should each of us get?



Why are 2008 dollar bills worth more than 2007 dollar bills?



If you buy a \$4 coffee each morning before school, how much will you spend on coffee by the end of the school year?



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If there are 8 working hours in a day, and you work Monday through Friday, how many working hours are there in a

Week?

Month?

Year?

Lifetime?



Assuming you work 40 hours per week, how much money would you need to make per hour to have a salary of \$1 million per year?



Ma Waddell made some pizza dough using extra strong yeast. When left in a warm place it always doubles in size every 24 hours. If it takes 4 days to rise to the top of her extra large bowl, after how long would it be exactly half way up the bowl?

How long does it take an investment to double at 5% compounded continuously?



If I had \$10 more than I do now, then I would have six times as much money as I would if I had \$10 less. How much money do I have?



You are trying to decide whether to take three friends to one movie or one friend to three movies. Which is cheaper?



A stack of 100 nickels has a height of 6.25 inches. What is the value, in dollars and cents, of an 8-foot high stack of nickels?



What is the largest amount of money you can have in coins and not be able to make change for a dollar?



Explain how the following could be true:

$$15 + 1 = 1$$

e.g. 15 tablespoons + 1 tablespoon = 1 cup

How many can you come up with?

Hint: There are some with money!



#### Literal Answers:

15 pennies + 1 dime = 1 quarter

15 nickels + 1 quarter = 1 dollar

15 dimes + 1 fifty-cent piece = 1 two-dollar bill

15 ounces + 1 ounce = 1 pound

15 cups + 1 cup = 1 gallon

15 fluid ounces + 1 fluid ounce = 1 pint

But then have some fun with it...

15 quarters + 1 dollar = 1 gallon of gas (very expensive gas!)

15 students + 1 teacher = 1 very small class

15 birthdays + 1 birthday = 1 legal driver

15 weeks of school + 1 week of finals = 1 college semester

15 days + 1 fortnight = 1 month of February in a leap year

15 minutes + 1 quarter hour = 1 half an hour

15 minutes + 1 half hour = 1 half a soccer game

15 electrons + 1 electron = 1 outer shell of a sulfur atom

15 Sundays + 1 Sunday = 1 NFL football season

15 pawns + 1 pawn = 1 set of chess pawns

15 hours + 1 hour = 1 waking part of the day (if you sleep 8 hours)

15 strikes + 1 fly ball = 1 inning of baseball

15 rounds of boxing + 1 quarter hour = 1 hour



Your boss is having a good month so she gives you a 10% raise. The next month is slow so she is forced to give you a 10% cut in salary. Are you back where you started?



Citizens of Newton pay as much income tax (percentagewise) as they make in dollars per week. What is the optimal salary in Newton?



The price of an item is cut 40% for a sale. When the sale is over, the storeowner wants to bring the price back up to where it was before the sale. What percentage of the sale price must be added to the sale price to bring the price back to the original selling price?
